our programs

Family Preservation & Family Reunification Program

Providing a range of counselling and support services for family, youth and children. Services include counselling work with children and youth, teaching parenting skills, child development and connecting families to available resources.

Day Program

Supports youth and their families in maintaining or establishing school work and/or vocation placement.

Restorative Justice Program

Targeted at young offenders who have committed less serious offences. Forums bring together victim and offender with family supporters to agree on appropriate restitution.

Francis House

A five-bed residential treatment program located in Vancouver, providing care and treatment services for youth with severe behavioural and emotional difficulties.

Community Action Program for Children (CAP-C)

A federally funded program that provides a supportive learning environment and community support to parents, grandparents, caregivers and their children aged 0-6 years.

Supervised Access

Designed for Richmond based families who have been separated and granted supervised access with their children.

StreetSmarts

StreetSmarts supports youth at risk of gang involvement to recognize the impact of their current choice of lifestyle and in turn, enable them to make better life decisions. We examine issues such as peer pressure and the influence of gang involvement on their lives, including family, school and community.
